SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

THE PROGRAM

In 2006, Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP established a scholarship program to assist high school seniors from select high schools who plan to continue their education in college programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited two- or four-year institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services®, a division of Scholarship America®. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP Scholarship Program must -

- be high school seniors attending one of the designated high schools in which Boardwalk's pipeline system crosses the school's property.
- maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale, and
- plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university for the entire upcoming academic year.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$1,000 award. One award will be given to each of the designated high schools, assuming there are qualified candidates. If there are no qualified applicants from a particular school, the total number of awards will be reduced accordingly.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **February 15, 2012**. Grade reports are not acceptable. To download the application form, go to: sms.scholarshipamerica.org/boardwalkpipelinepartners.

Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any officer or employee of Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Scholarship Management Services as final.

Applicants will be notified in early April 2012. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Management Services processes scholarship payments on behalf of Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP. Payments are made in one installment on August 15, 2012. A check will be mailed to each recipient's home address and is made payable to the college or university as designated by the student.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP. They are, however, required to supply Scholarship Management Services with complete transcripts when requested and to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.

REVISIONS

Boardwalk Pipeline Partners, LP reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
