

Sonus Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

The Sonus Scholarship Foundation has established a scholarship program to assist 3rd and 4th year AuD students. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services[®], a division of Scholarship America[®]. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Sonus Scholarship Program must be -

- Currently enrolled in a full-time* course of study as a 3rd or 4th year AuD student

**Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year.*

Employees of Sonus, Scholarship America, their subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies and their immediate family (spouses, parents, children or siblings and their spouses) and persons living in the same household of such employees, who are employed at the time of application, are ineligible to receive a scholarship.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$2,500 award. Up to eight (8) awards will be granted each year. Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **May 8**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed by Scholarship Management Services and may be released to Sonus and Sonus Scholarship Foundation.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any officer or employee of the Sonus Scholarship Foundation or Sonus play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified by mid June. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Management Services processes Sonus Scholarship payments on behalf of the Sonus Scholarship Foundation. Payments are made in equal installments on August 15 and December 30. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to Sonus or Sonus Scholarship Foundation. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS

The Sonus Scholarship Foundation reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
