



Forge Your Future Today Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

Weber Metals, Inc. has established a scholarship program to assist students who are continuing their education in a college or vocational school program. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services[®], a division of Scholarship America[®]. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Weber Metals *Forge Your Future Today Scholarship Program* must be -

- Students who are currently enrolled in a full-time* undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school in the United States. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents. The following majors are eligible:

Four-year College or University

Engineering and technology majors with concentration in the study of:

Aerospace	Material Science
Design	Mechanical
Industrial	Quality Assurance
Manufacturing	

Two-year College or Vocational-Technical School

These scholarships are open to applicants attending schools only in Los Angeles and Orange Counties. Heavy industrial majors with concentration in the study of Industrial Electronics including:

Coordinate Measuring Machine (CMM)	Operating/Programming
Combustion	Machining
Dimensional Inspection	Metrology
Heat Treatment	Non-Destructive & Destructive Testing
Hydraulics	Open or Closed Die Forging
Industrial Maintenance	Program Logic Controls (PLC)

**Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year.*

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$2,000 award. Up to five (5) awards will be granted each year. Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **March 31, 2010**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered. Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any officer or employee of Weber Metals, Inc. play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified in mid-May. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Management Services processes Weber Metals *Forge Your Future Today* scholarship payments on behalf of Weber Metals, Inc. Payments are made in equal installments on August 15 and December 30. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to Weber Metals, Inc. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS

Weber Metals, Inc. reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
